## **Alerts from Grayslake Police Department**

Back in October, our school district experienced a few very difficult days when an individual was wanted for a series of alleged crimes in our area. During that time, questions arose from some community members regarding how to best receive information outside of the alerts that may be provided by the school district.

Recently, I met with the Grayslake Chief of Police. I offered to Chief Perlini that I would share out the following message from him, which I hope that you will find helpful:

The best way residents can sign up for community notification is through this link: (Village of Grayslake). A second way to sign up is via Smart911 (https://www.smart911.com/). Smart911 is available to sign up on-line or via an app. Individuals can sign up using both formats. By registering, your phone will receive all Village of Grayslake notifications (not only emergencies).

We do what we can to keep our social media up to date, but the Village's Facebook and other social media (including the police accounts) are not constantly monitored or updated. Social Media may not be the most up to date source of information and should not be relied upon solely for latest information, especially during non-business hours.
