**Synchronous** This is difficult to maintain after doing it for two years. Kids weren't interested



It Should NOT be treated as a regular day, or like a day during the public quarantine. It should be a check-in with activities to complete at leisure. There is not enough planning time to successfully do more. Asking families to do more on short notice is hard on everyone.

**Asynchronous** All learning should be asynchronous/a quick meeting in the morning. Families have all different situations on a last minute e-learning days.

Teachers should be able to use discretion with continuing curriculum on the ELearning Days instead of coming up with something disconnected. If the goal is to ensure there are no gaps in learning then we should be able to continue from the day prior and make up random assignments.



Snow days are fun! We all grew up with snow days, and a day or two at the end of the year is a small price to pay for a random fun day. It's also so much easier for working parents to get childcare (if needed) when they don't have to ask for someone to also assist with e-learning.
