SUMMER SCHOOL HIGHLIGHTS



This summer, CCSD 46 offered several summer programs for students. In addition to the online Illinois Virtual Schools and Academy program which was offered through the Lake County Regional Office of Education, CCSD 46 offered our Adelante/Multilingual Summer Program to incoming students in pre-kindergarten through seventh grade who had qualified for an English Learner Program or had exited the program in the past year. This four-week program ran from June 3-June 27 at Park Campus.

CCSD 46 also offered an Extended School Year program for students leaving grades K-7th who were eligible through their IEP. This four-week program ran from June 3-June 27 at Prairieview School.

GENERAL MEETING: June 26, 2024

The CCSD 46 Board of Education held a general meeting on Wednesday, June 26, 2024, in the Falcon Room of Frederick School.

President Stephen Mack called the meeting to order at 6:04 pm. Four members of the Board of Education were in attendance for the meeting: Stephen Mack, Kristy Braden, Jason Lacroix, and Jim Weidman. Members Jessica Albert, Kristy Miller, and Tamika Nash were absent. Also in attendance at the Board table were: Superintendent, Dr. Lynn Glickman; Assistant Superintendent, Amy Gluck; Assistant Superintendent, Chris Wildman; Director of Special Services, Heather Lorenzo; Director of Human Resources, Chris Wolk; Director of Multilingual, Stephanie Diaz; Director of Innovation, Amanda Pelsor, and Interim Director of Operations and Maintenance, Scott Gaunky.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, the approval of the agenda, and the opportunity for public comment, Board members gave reports on the activities they've attended and general information sharing took place. The Superintendent also shared that the District Leadership Team attended a leadership retreat which took place on June 17 in a collaboration with Lake Villa District 41. Amy Gluck shared details on the retreat, and Amanda Pelsor shared information regarding the registration process and the progress we've made on ensuring our families are registering for next year in a timely manner.

President Mack then requested a motion for the approval of the Consent Agenda, which includes Minutes from previous meetings, the Personnel Report, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Review, Exception Report, Accounts Payable, Treasurer's Report. The motion carried.

Unfinished Business, which are unresolved issues that were previously brought before the Board to be discussed further included:

- Strategic Goals Update - During the 2020-2021 school year, the Board of Education contracted with Educational Leadership Solutions to facilitate a strategic planning process. Each year following, goals and action steps have been updated. Members of the Leadership Team presented their action steps for the upcoming school year to the Board.

New Business, which are new issues for the Board to discuss, included the following:

- Parent-Teacher Advisory Committee discussions on student cell phones, student smart watches, student wireless headphones, student hate speech, and an update to Board Policy 7:190.
- ParentSquare communications tool purchase recommendation for the 2024-2025 school year.
- Strategic Planning for the future.

As the meeting drew to a close, topics for future agenda items were discussed, the public once again had an opportunity to address the Board of Education, and the Board entered into Closed Session. The Board adjourned the Open Session of the meeting at 8:06 pm.
