| <p><i>New Business</i></p> | <p>Levy Discussion- Mr. Chris Wildman, Assistant Superintendent of Finance, presented levy options to the Board of Education in light of the recent projected 2024 Equalized Assessed Valuation (EAV) increase. He provided financial projections for the district, highlighting the doubling of special education outplacement tuition over the past eight years, the rising transportation costs for student transport, the costs of employee benefits, and the financial impact of providing interpretation services for newcomer services. The Board invited audience questions from the Citizens Task Force to gather input on the various options. After three meetings and extensive discussion, the Board decided to increase the levy to \$7,845,012 million with a full one-year abatement.</p> |
