# Argonne Science Discovery Camp

Explore, Experiment, Innovate at a free, five-day camp experience

Is your middle school student very curious about STEM (science, technology, engineering and math) beyond the classroom? In Argonne Science Discovery Camp, rising eighth and ninth graders with a developing passion in the STEM areas come together to learn about the exciting work done at a national laboratory! By working in groups on hands-on projects, interviewing science and technology experts, and touring the labs and world-renowned scientific facilities, campers hone their skills and gain insight into the future of science and technology!

In this **free**, five-day enrichment experience, campers will learn about several STEM fields that Argonne specializes in, from computing to future energy innovations! This camp is designed for students that have a high curiosity about science and want to learn more and who enjoy working in groups with others. The camp will include opportunities for open-ended exploration and projects, creativity and teamwork that model how Argonne scientists do their exciting work.

In this camp, participants can expect to:

- Work with other STEM-interested students on fun, hands-on projects and activities that connect to the work done at the laboratory for which Argonne is famous around the world.
- Meet Argonne scientists and engineers and ask what it's really like to work at a national laboratory and have a career in STEM areas.
- Discover exciting areas of science and the latest discoveries!
- Hone STEM skills in a confidence-building environment.
